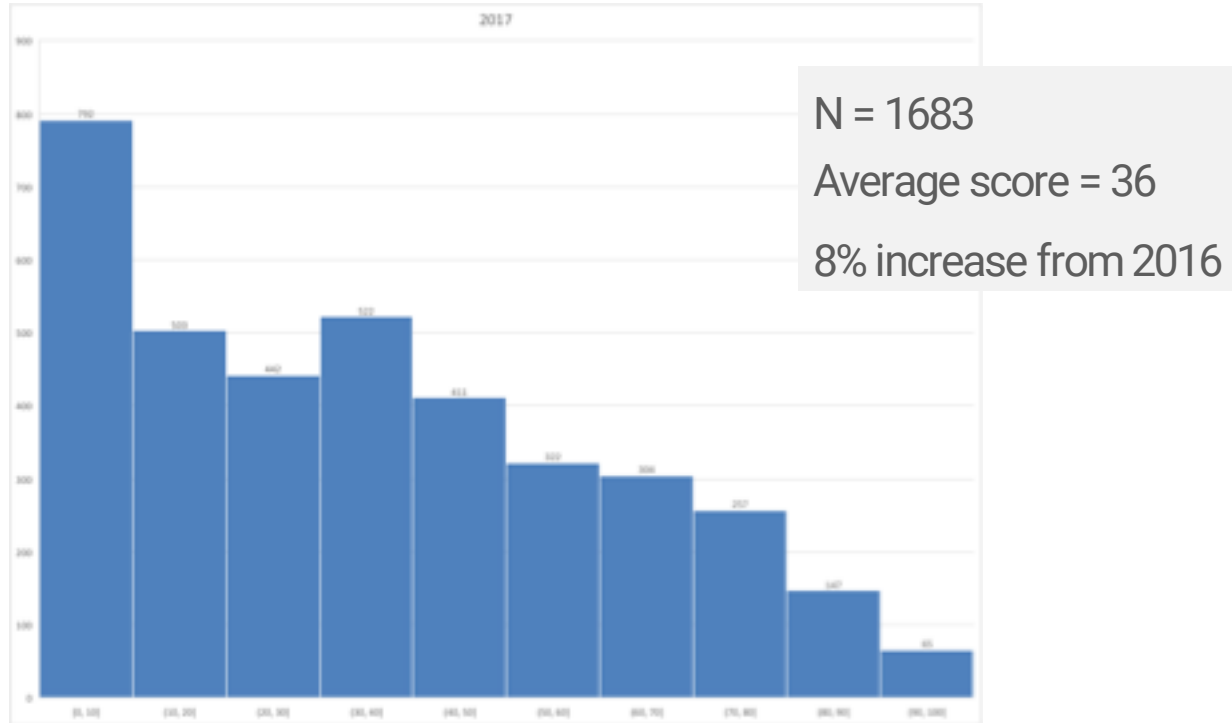

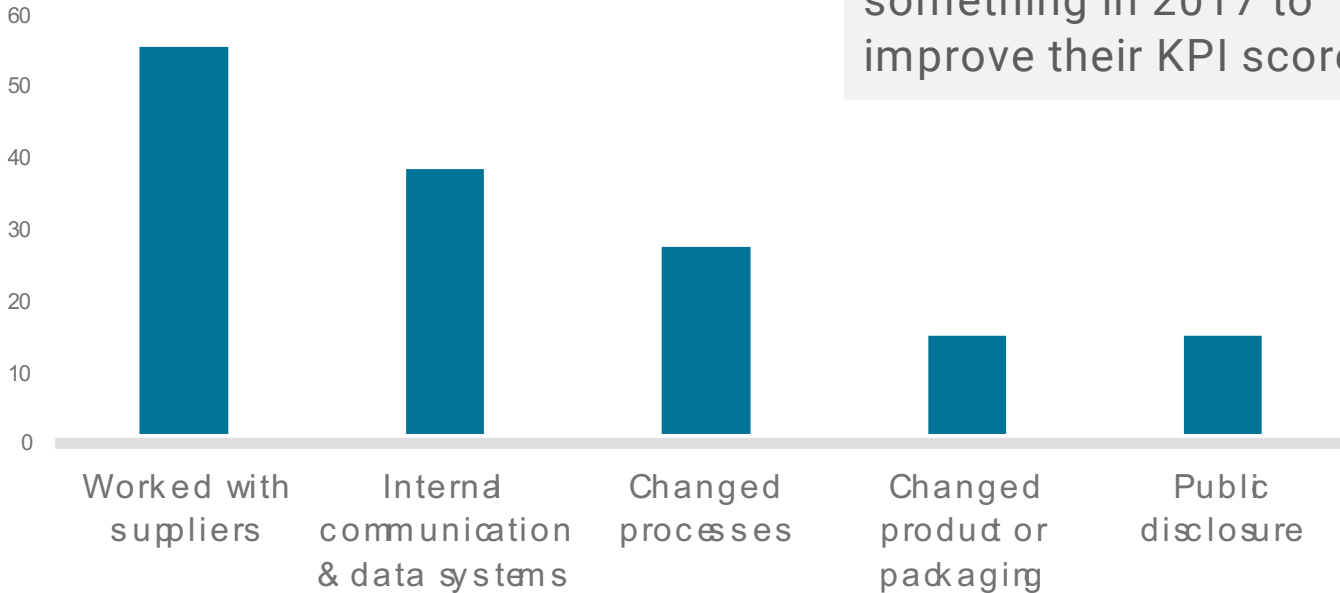

88% of respondents did something in 2017 to improve their KPI scores

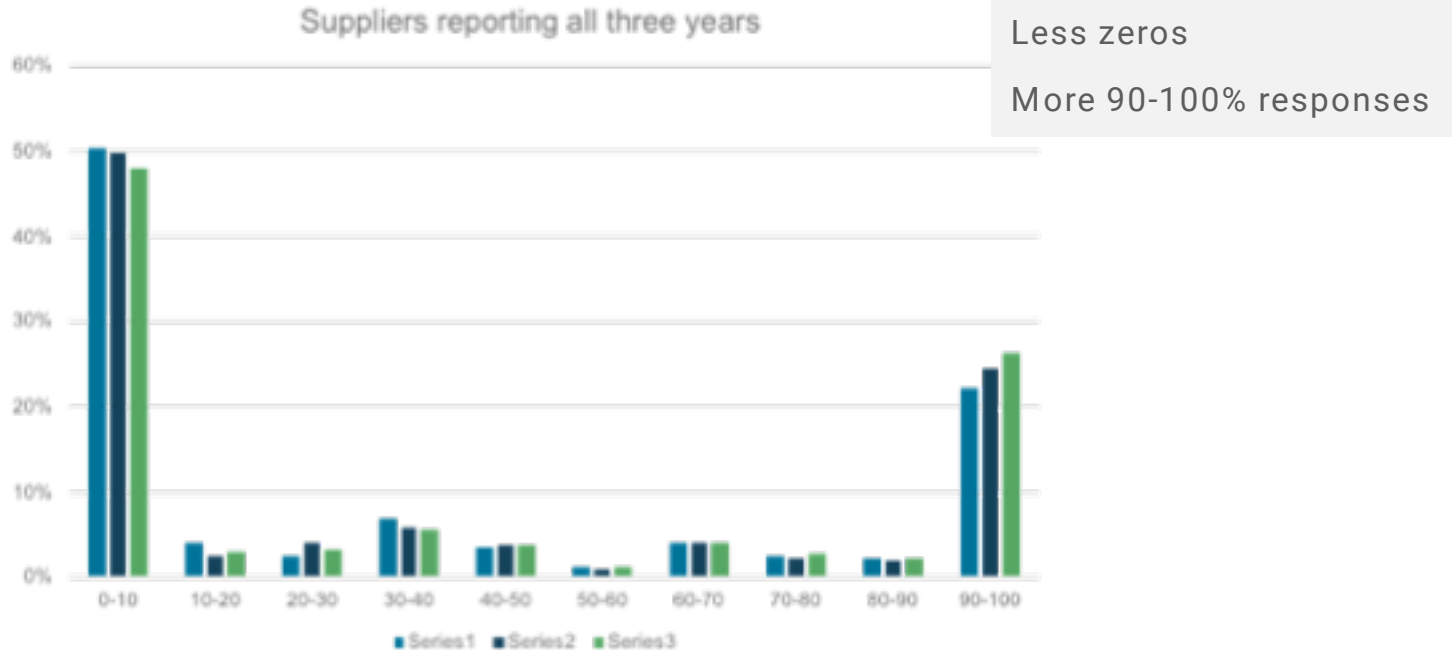

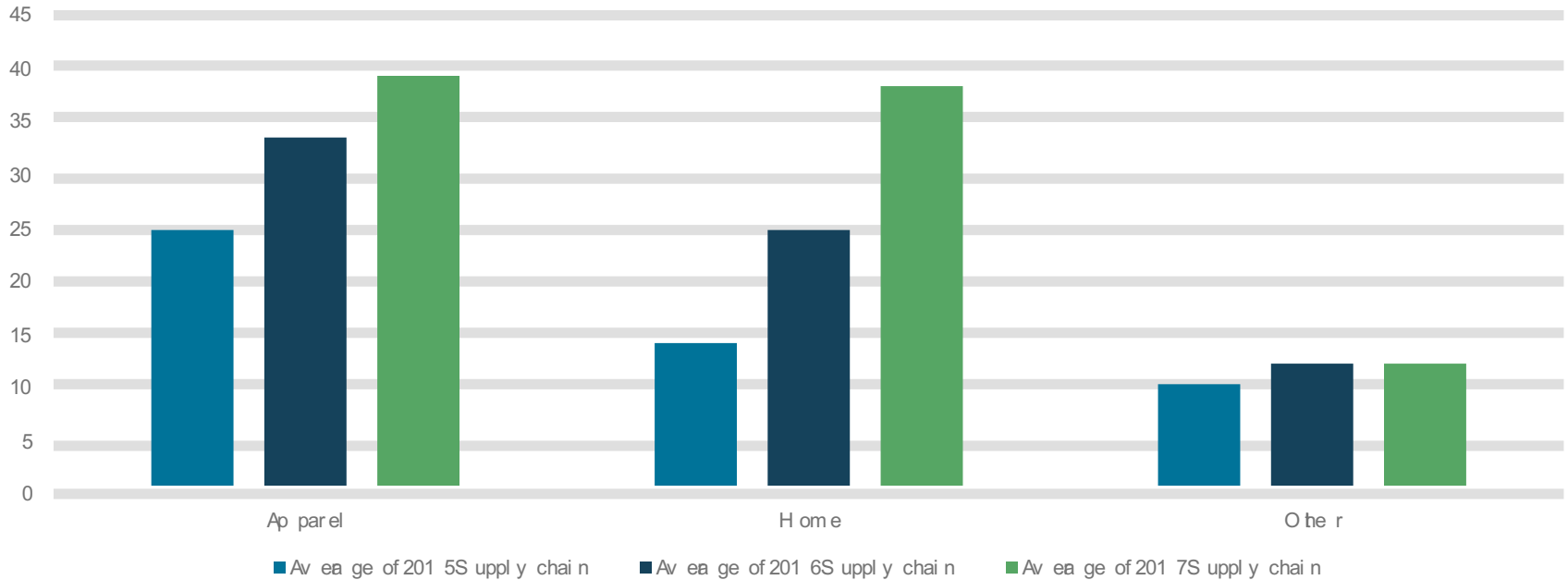
Change in scores (2015-17)

KPI-level scores



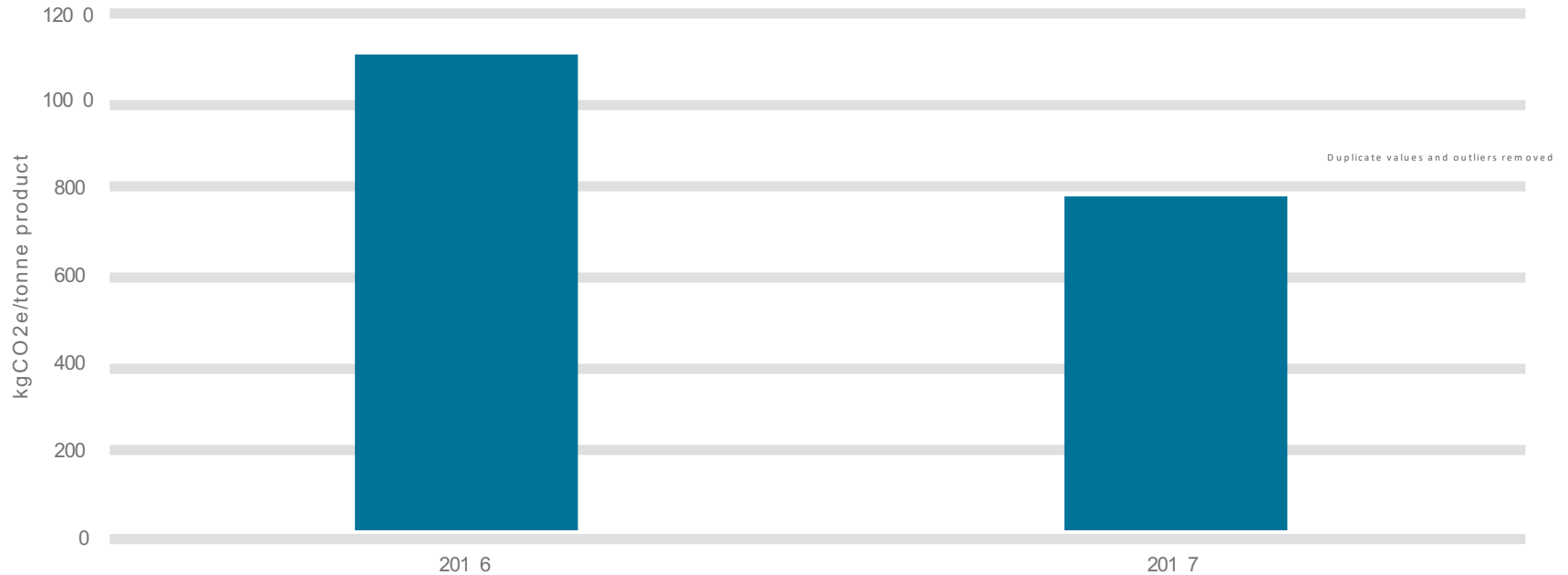
Supply chain GHG - Textiles
